

During our Eucharistic this morning, we will once again commission you and ask the continual blessing of our Gracious God upon you as you minister to these children.


The catechists would love to hear from any parishioner who would like to join them in this rewarding yet, at times, challenging ministry.

Bishop John Aloysius Morgan passed away on Wednesday evening, 21st May, after returning from Calvary Hospital to his home at Villaggio Sant' Antonio in Canberra. At the age of 98 years, he was the fifth oldest Catholic bishop in the world.

He began a long-time connection with the armed services when he became a chaplain with the Australian Army in 1941. He served in New Guinea and was present at the formal surrender of the Japanese at Wewak in September 1945. He was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of Canberra and Goulburn in March 1969. He retired as bishop in 1985. May he rest in peace.
