The Body and Blood of Christ Year C



A reflection in "The Summit" contrasts "the attitude of Jesus towards the crowd...with the attitude of the twelve. Jesus welcomes all who come..., patiently explains his message of the kingdom and offers healing to all... By contrast, the twelve, in the face of their paucity of resources, suggest that the crowd must be sent away to search out their own nourishment. Jesus presents them with a model of how they should respond with generosity and trust in God. Significantly, Jesus hands back the food to the apostles to distribute among the crowd. They are given the ministry of feeding the multitude. ...the Church, founded on the twelve must never cease to nourish those who come seeking healing and the kingdom. ...each one of us has the responsibility to use what resources we have to meet the needs of others." pV

The Blackheath Conference of St Vincent de Paul assisted 354 families in the past year. More than half these families were surviving on the Disability Support Pension (174). Single parent families were the next biggest group (96). The high cost of private rental (\$200 per week) leaves these families with very little disposable income to meet basic needs. We have helped these families with food parcels (\$10 000) from the food bank at Katoomba as well as giving them vouchers for fruit, vegetables, meat, pharmaceuticals, power and winter heating. Your generous donations go to helping those who are in great need in the Blackheath Community.
