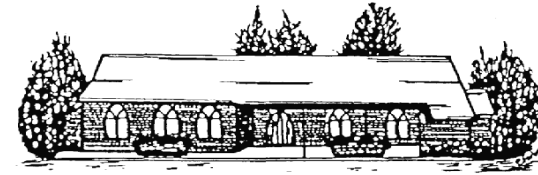
in a nutshell
