


# **Fourth Sunday** of Lent Year A 2 March 2008

# **Lenten Journey Reflection** Journey to the Heart For Week 5:

# 'Coming to the Heart'

**Theme**: Our journey approaches its goal. Our journey leads us into the heart of our God. Yet before we can fully allow God to live within us. we must confront an incredible hurdle. We must die to ourselves. We must explore what such a death means for us.

Read: Gospel of John 11:1-45

Reflect: In April 2006, after two weeks of entombment, two men walked out of Beaconsfield Mine punching their fists in the air! After four days in a tomb, a well and truly dead Lazarus emerges fully alive! The euphoria we experienced gives us a sense of the raising of Lazarus. Jesus comes to set us free too, from all that binds us up. How and when do we experience this freedom?

Martha's faith in Jesus Christ shifts from a question of what he may be able to do, to understanding who he is in her life. She is able to affirm that he is her life, her resurrection. regardless of what happens. What wrappings still bind us or our community from walking forth into freedom in Christ?
