# What is a parish mission?

The renewal or mission offered by the Thomas More Centre is best compared to a retreat. We invite people to take time during the five days to attend as many sessions as possible, given the busy schedules we all have, to consider their relationships, with God, with family and with the broader community. It is a time of relaxation and refreshment.

Our talks are all based on Scriptural themes. We believe that most Catholics have a lot of "catching up" to do with regard to understanding the Scriptures and so we make this a priority.

# **SESSIONS**

The renewal begins Sunday evening and concludes Thursday evening. There is a two hour session each evening and each morning in that span of time. There are nine sessions. **EACH SESSION IS A DIFFERENT TOPIC.** 

The format for each session is:

- Opening Hymn
- \* Prayer
- Preaching (30 40 minutes approx)
- \* Break (15 minutes approx)
- \* Question Time

During question time, the whole audience is invited to ask questions of the Preaching Team. The open discussion period is one of the most valuable parts of the entire renewal.
