Lent is here!

Wednesday next, 17th February, is Ash Wednesday, which introduces the forty day period of Lent. This year the early Lenten period will lead to an equally early Easter, when Easter Sunday will be celebrated on 4th April. This date also happens to be the end of our daylight savings' period.

The word Lent has its origin in an old English word for spring, the season in which Lent occurs in the Northern Hemisphere.

The practice of penance emanates from Jesus Himself, who preached repentance to all. Of historic interest is the fact that the first mention of a forty day fast (raised in last week's Bulletin), occurred at the Council of Nicaea in 325AD. Many other changes were made down through the centuries, resulting in the 1966 Proclamation of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as the only days of fast and abstinence in our Church Year.

Lent is THE annual period of repentance, in which we each review our present lives and, where necessary, revise and, at the very least, renew our Christian commitment to God and our neighbour.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed their 18th year, until the beginning of their 60th year; the law of abstinence (from meat) binds those who have completed their 14th year. Also, Catholics are obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday. Implicit in this is our receipt of the Sacrament of Reconciliation prior to our receiving Holy Communion. During Lent you will note that the Alleluia is omitted at Mass, even in celebration of solemnities and feasts.

St Valentine's Day

St Valentine's Day is one of the very few special occasions in each year, where we are able to publicly express our love for another. Despite the Americanisation of this feast, it had its origins in a 3rd century Roman priest named Valentine, who assisted many martyrs during the reign of Claudius II. Apprehended, he himself suffered martyrdom about the year 270AD. The custom of sending valentines on this day is the revival of an ancient pagan practice which consisted in boys drawing the names of girls in honour of their goddess Februata Juno on February 15th. To abolish this practice, names of saints were substituted by Christians on billets drawn upon this day, hence St Valentine's popularity through this practice.
