The infection which caused him to almost lose his life by closing down his organs, has moderated to the point where only his kidneys have failed to respond to treatment. Having spoken to his nurse, the feeling is that he will be transferred to that hospital's high dependency unit by the end of this week. He is, however, still a very, very sick priest who needs all the prayers that we can muster on his behalf, so please keep him in your prayers.

To all who attended last Sunday's Mass, it would be obvious that there is a close personal relationship between Fr John and Fr Paul who so graciously stood in for me. Thank you everyone for your heart-warming hospitality extended to Fr Paul on this occasion.

As to our newly retired Bishop Kevin Manning, he has taken up permanent residence in his own home at 4 Woodville Road, Glenbrook. We wish him good health, happiness and holiness in his new role.
