HOLY WEEK

Holy Week by definition is the most holy week of the Church year. Commencing today (Passion/Palm Sunday) and continuing through to Holy Thursday, when the Easter Triduum takes over, up to and including Easter Sunday, this time is the culmination of the whole 40 day Lenten period. Our preparation for Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection will be completed during the course of this week.

Activities to take place during the next seven days include the Parramatta Diocesan Chrism Mass to be celebrated by Bishop Fisher this Wednesday, with concelebration by all Parish Priests and at which the Holy Oils to be used within all parishes are to be either blessed or consecrated during this Mass. All Priests within our Diocese will also renew their vows.

There will be no morning Mass on Holy Thursday, as in the evening, the Mass of the Lord's Supper will commence at 7.30pm. Please also note that on Holy Saturday the Easter Vigil Mass will commence at 7.30pm at Blackheath. As a result there will be no Saturday Vigil Mass at Mt Victoria on this occasion.

Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated in all three churches commencing at Mt Victoria at 7.00am, Blackheath at 9.30am and at 12 noon in the Megalong Valley.

A LAST WORD ON RECONCILIATION

Congratulations to all who participated in the Second Rite of Reconciliation held on Wednesday evening last at Blackheath. While the numbers attending were not great (about 25) this Liturgy and the Sacrament of Reconciliation were enthusiastically received by those attending. However, I draw attention to those who have yet to make their minimum annual confession that it is a requirement of our Church that every Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Initiation MUST receive this Sacrament at some time between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday. Failure to do so is a serious sin.


Good Friday - Gathering for Sunset and Darkness over the Earth.


