NOVEMBER - A MONTH TO REMEMBER

Commencing with the first day of November - All Saints' Day, which is a Solemnity Feast of our universal church, this month is a time for us to remember our departed loved ones in a very special way. As has been the usual practice in this parish, a Remembrance Book will be in place for parishioners to list the names of their departed loved ones.

We do this so that our community may honour them in their prayers throughout November. Additionally, should you wish to, you could place their name, in front of our altar, there to remain throughout the month. Blank cards will be available next to the Remembrance Book. Also, special envelopes are available for those who wish to have individual masses celebrated in honour of their loved ones.

November is a special time to pray for our dead. A plenary indulgence may be gained for the dead, once only, by visiting a church on 2nd November and praying the Lord's Prayer and the Creed. Three conditions are required for gaining the indulgence; Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions. These three requirements may be satisfied within a reasonable time of 2nd November.

Finally, you are reminded that Tuesday, 2nd November, is All Souls' Day. Those wishing to participate in the Mass can do so here at the normal time of 6.30pm.

THE MASS IS CHANGING AND WHY?

Why has the Holy See desired a more literal translation of the Roman missal?

One concern is that the current translation often uses casual, everyday language that does not reflect the sense of the sacred in the original. Many languages have an elevated, formal way of speaking that is used in worship. Formality underscores the sacredness of the experience and helps us recognize the glory and majesty of God. The new translation uses a more formal, elevated tone that seeks to lift the mind and heart to God.
