We have received the following letter dated 15th May 2011 which reads as follows:

"Dear Parishioners, I'm writing as an inmate at Long Bay Jail. I'm 26, with 2 years to go until eligible for parole. I'm looking to live up the Blue Mountains when I get out. From what I've seen of the community up there, and scenery, it's exactly what I need. I got your address from the Blue Mountains Gazette's Easter Special, one of the other inmates gets this sent in. I don't have much support on the outside apart from my mother who lives in Tamworth, and a few friends in Sydney. So, I'm looking to get to know some people up the mountains, to get the lay of the land and discern the services up there. My grandfather was a (Bible only) pastor all his life, living to about 97, so Christianity has been a major influence in my life, though I have my own ideas about it. I've investigated the Catholics a bit, read the Marist messenger, Journal of Catholic Culture, contacted the Centre for Catholic inquiry, attended the services here and spoken to the Catholic Chaplain on four times (Peter Carroll). I've still a lot to discern about the Catholic faith. If it could be arranged for a pen friend of sorts, to write to me, this would be most helpful and appreciated"... Daniel
