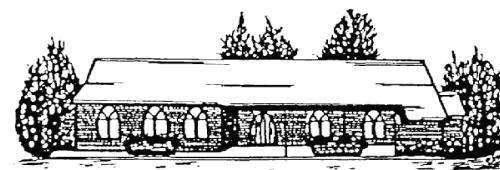

The Emmaus story is one of the best known in the scriptures and is often quoted as exemplifying our personal journey. The sadness and confusion of the two disciples as they walked to Emmaus symbolise our own struggles. When Jesus met them they did not recognise him, just as we are not able to see a way through our difficulties for a time. As Jesus revealed himself, the disciples gained new understanding and were transformed.



Similarly, to paraphrase Judy Cannato's words in 'Field of Compassion', if we wade out to the cusp of the unknown, respond in care and compassion and act with energy and faith, we can participate in transforming our world. Surely the Emmaus story is one of hope. It reminds us that new life—resurrection—lies beyond our struggles. We pray for the faith and courage to persist in times of challenge.

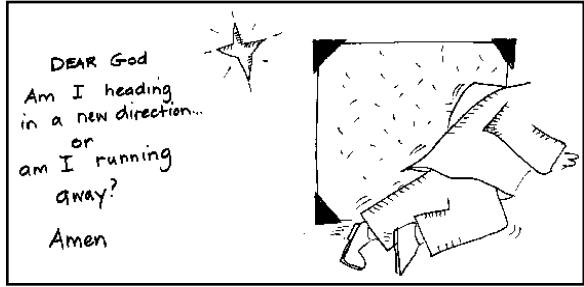

Maybe it is hospitality, making space for others and taking time to truly gather the assembly that will enable us to recognise Jesus when we break bread today.
