

### LAETARE SUNDAY

Today, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, is one of the two occasions in our church year when the priest is entitled to wear pink vestments, I might add that this is an optional choice which is just as well, as I don't possess any pink vestments, about which I have spoken on previous occasions. Laetare is taken from the Latin, whose meaning is "rejoice with Jerusalem", the other Sunday for pink vestments is Gaudete Sunday which falls on the Third Sunday of Advent for those interested. From this Sunday forward, our attention will particularly focus on Jesus' Passion, Crucifixion and Resurrection.

### 2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER - FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY

On May 5th, 2000, Pope John Paul II, decreed that the 2nd Sunday of Easter be also called Divine Mercy Sunday as the Gospel and Readings of this day recall the merciful gifts Our Lord has bestowed on us. On June 13th, 2000, the Pope granted plenary indulgences attached to this day under the usual conditions, i.e. sacramental Confession. Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff, being those of the Our Father, the Creed and a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Iesus (i.e. Merciful Iesus, I Trust in You).

To further honour this Feast Day, a special celebration will be held at St Bonaventure's Church, Leura, commencing at 2.45pm Sunday, April 15th. Further information will be published closer to that date. For enquiries, contact Bill Grieves at 4787 6687.
