

PASSION/PALM SUNDAY

Sunday next, the Sixth Sunday of Lent is Passion (Palm) Sunday, at which palms will be distributed to each attending parishioner. This will follow an entry procession and blessing of palms at the beginning of Mass. Proclamation of Our Lord's Passion will also be part of this Mass. Those attending weekday Masses will note that from Tuesday, 27th March, we begin the lead-in to Our Lord's Passion via the introduction of the Preface of The Passion of Our Lord. Holy Week will commence with Passion Sunday and will continue through the last days of Lent and the Easter Triduum. In passing, we thank Norma Carlon for arranging our supply of palms for this year.

RECONCILIATION - SECOND RITE

Arrangements have been finalised for interested parishioners to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation via the **Second Rite on Wednesday**, 28th March, commencing at 7pm. We are reminded that the decision taken at the 4th Lateran Council in the Year 1215, that every Catholic should receive this Sacrament at least once a year, between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday, As this will be the only opportunity for you to receive the Second Rite of Reconciliation during this Lenten/Paschal season, it could be a good time for you to fulfil this obligation. Fr Paul Hanna and myself will be present.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS ENDS

As from 2am next Sunday (Palm Sunday), Daylight Savings will end and we will return to Eastern Standard Time, that is, put your clock back one hour which will make our Sunday Mass time an hour later than it has been throughout Summer.
