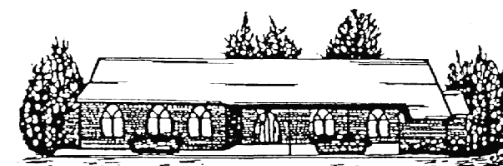
How are we to understand the mystery of the Trinity?

**The Logo:** There is no one symbol or message that the Year of Grace logo is intended to convey. It is a bright and stylish image which, in looking at it, has many significant symbols and connections that can be drawn:

- The cross
- The sun
- A circle that represents the infinity of God
- The halo incorporating a cross that surrounds the head of Jesus in Eastern iconography
- The host used at Mass
- The monstrance used in Eucharistic adoration
- A link with the artistic tradition of our Indigenous people
- The earthen, ochre colours of Australia
- A diversity of peoples and cultures, gathered into one community
- A star-burst
- Light



There may be other ways in which the logo speaks to people.

#### GREAT FEASTS ABOUND

We are in the Sundays of the truly great themes of Catholic life: last week Pentecost; this week, The Trinity; next week, the Body and Blood of Christ or 'Corpus Christi'. However, not all of these seasons' great feasts fall on a Sunday, for example, 31 May (last Thursday) was the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, while on 15 June (a Friday), the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus followed by the Memorial Feast of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary on 16 June (a Saturday) will occur. As these are very important feasts in the church year, please make a note of them with the intention of undertaking a special devotion on those dates.
