

Bishop Anthony will celebrate a Memorial Mass for the Victims of Typhoon Haiyan tomorrow evening, Monday 18th November, at 7.30pm in Parramatta's St Patrick's Cathedral.

KEVIN LEE, a former controversial priest of the Diocese of Parramatta, is one of those who was a fatal victim of that same Typhoon Haiyan. I both quote and completely support Bishop Anthony's Statement when he says ... "I extend my deepest sympathy to his widow, Josefina, and her children during this time of personal tragedy for them and devastation for the people of the Philippines in the aftermath of Typhoon Haiyan. I also extend my condolences to Kevin's parents and family here in their deep sorrow.

Last year, Kevin left his ministry as a Catholic priest in very public circumstances and was recently 'laicised' at his request. He had made a new life with Josefina and they recently celebrated the birth of a daughter. Difficult as was the mode of his departure, we honour the work Kevin did as the founding Parish Priest of Padre Pio Parish, Glenmore Park, and his ministry as a chaplain with NSW Police."

Bishop Anthony is to celebrate a Memorial Mass for Kevin Lee at St Thomas Aquinas' Church, 168 Hawkesbury Road, Springwood at 11.00am Monday, 18th November 2013.


Here at Sacred Heart, Blackheath we have already celebrated a Mass for Kevin Lee last Tuesday, 12th November at the 6.30pm Mass.


