

Ascension Sunday: Today we celebrate the second of the three major feasts which collectively make up the Easter Season. First, of course, was Easter Sunday and the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. Today we celebrate His return to His Father in Heaven via the Feast we call The Ascension. Last of all is the Feast of Pentecost where we celebrate the descent of the Advocate (the Most Holv Spirit) to take Jesus' place among all people, then and now. Tradition tells us that Jesus' Ascension took place in the same Garden of Gethsemane where He had just a few weeks earlier, suffered the beginning of the trauma which was His Passion and Death. With Him on this occasion were those closest to Him to bear witness to His departure from us. We perhaps need to be reminded that once ascended into Heaven, Jesus, as our Saviour, has supported us on our difficult journey in this life. and in the judgement to follow for us.

Pentecost Sunday: Sunday next is the Feast of Pentecost, as referred to above. This Feast of the Descent of the Most Holy Spirit, the Advocate promised and sent by Jesus, is the birthday of the Church. As one of the antiphons reads "Lord, send out Your spirit and renew the face of the earth". There is much in our world that needs renewing. Pentecost Sunday invites us into the mystery of the Trinity - the love that God has for us and how we are held in that love. The Trinity is about relationships - the love of the Father for the Son and the love of the Son for the Father – this love being so perfect that is the Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity. More about Pentecost next week.

Mother's Day: Mother's Day has historically been a day to honour mums. Traditionally, mums were recognised in church. Parishioners wore symbolic carnations as a means to honour mothers both living and deceased. So it is natural that pravers would take a central part in any Mother's Day celebration. As for me. I take this opportunity to honour all mothers including my own, who are both special and unique. Mothers are the heart of every family. As this is the day we set aside each year to honour our mothers, at the conclusion of today's Mass we will certainly share a prayer with all parishioners to honour our mothers.
