



The Great Feast Days are Here: We are in the middle of those Sundays that are the truly great themes of Catholic life. Today's Feast of Pentecost this week in which we celebrate the descent of the Most Holy Spirit (the Advocate promised and sent by Jesus) is also the birthday of the Church.
