

EASTER GREETINGS: A day to celebrate! Renewed! Revitalized! Refreshed! Weight loss for many, we have emerged from our Lenten sacrifices to the new dawn of our Christian life in keeping with the commemoration of Christ's Resurrection that we celebrate today. May you experience the fullness of His personal love for you, also the peace and happiness which He brings into your life, and the lives of your family and those precious to you on this greatest of all Feasts of Christ. Too, I take this opportunity on behalf of myself and all parishioners to thank everyone who has made this year's Lent and Easter so special for all of us via their contribution to the planning and conduct of this Season's Liturgies. This particularly includes the Music Group whose efforts were amazing! Finally, as ever, a very special "thank you" to Father Paul for his wonderful, selfless support of us here at Sacred Heart, especially during these Lenten and Easter celebrations. HAPPY EASTER, EVERYONE!

CANONIZATION OF TWO POPES: Sunday next, 27th April, will witness the Canonization of Popes John XXIII and John Paul II by Pope Francis. The actual canonization will take place in Rome Sunday evening our time. With no special activity planned within our Diocese as far as I can tell, the only meaningful celebration of this unique event in Church history will be that to be held in St Mary's Cathedral Sydney that Sunday afternoon from 3.00pm. We will, of course, find some way to publicly recognise (on a small scale) the canonization of these two great popes and saints - perhaps during next Sunday's Mass.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY (27th April): As you can see, next Sunday is also the Feast of Divine Mercy, that feast proclaimed for us by Pope John Paul II at the canonization of St Faustina Kowalska on 30th April, in the year 2000. In his proclamation, Pope John Paul said "... It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the Word of God on this 2nd Sunday of Easter which, from now on throughout the Church, will be called **Divine Mercy** Sunday." The readings on that Sunday are always about mercy, trust and the forgiveness of sins. Locally, special celebrations are to be held on the day from 2.45pm at St Bonaventure's Church, Leura. So, spread the word among your friends.

ANZAC DAY: Friday next, 25th April, is ANZAC DAY. A suitably themed Mass will be celebrated at the normal time of 9.00am that day. We will then have the time to adjourn to the Blackheath War Memorial in time for the start of their main ceremony from 10.45am. We will be laying a wreath at the Memorial during that Remembrance Service on behalf of all parishioners. Lest we forget!

MARY HART'S FUNERAL: A Requiem Mass is to be held at Sacred Heart Church, Blackheath on Wednesday next, 23rd April, commencing at 10.30am. This will be followed by interment with her deceased husband's remains in Botany cemetery, Sydney. Locally, a "wake" is being arranged for about 12 noon in our parish hall for those who want to honour Mary's memory without taking the long trek to Botany. Mary passed away in Katoomba Hospital in the early hours of Saturday morning, 12th April. Additional Masses have already been said for the safe repose of Mary's soul. R.I.P. MARY!
