

MASSES THIS WEEK: Sadly, there will be no 9am Mass Wednesday of this coming week (28/5), due to my required attendance at a one-day seminar to be held from 10am - 2pm at St Patrick's Hall, Parramatta. I apologise for any inconvenience this causes.

Additionally, as next Saturday is the fifth Saturday in the month, there will be NO Vigil Mass celebrated at either Mt Victoria or Megalong Valley to commemorate the Feast of the Ascension. This significant feast will, therefore, be exclusive to Blackheath's Sunday 9.30am Mass.

OTHER DATES TO REMEMBER: Here, for us to consider, is a list of some important dates that could affect us between now and the end of the year. First, I remind everyone that I will be on two weeks annual leave from 2nd – 16th June. Fr Paul Hanna will celebrate the Blackheath Sunday Masses on both 8th and 15th June. Regrettably, at this juncture, there will be no other Masses/Sacraments available during this period. I will advise emergency alternative contacts in next week's bulletin. Other dates include Ascension Sunday (1/6), Pentecost Sunday (8/6), Queen's Birthday (9/6), Trinity Sunday (15/6), Corpus Christi (22/6), School Term 2 ends (27/6), Annual Parish Dinner (5/7); School term 3 starts (14/7), St Mary of the Cross Mackillop's Feast (8/8), Assumption of Our Lady Feast – Holy Day of Obligation (15/8), Diocesan Audit of our parish (17/9), School Term 3 ends (19/9), Sacrament of Confirmation (21/9), Daylight Savings Starts (6/10), School Term 4 starts (7/10), Pope Paul VI's Canonization (19/10), Melbourne Cup Fun Day (4/11), Church Year ends (29/11), School Term 4 ends (19/12). That's the best I can do for the time being!

ASCENSION & PENTECOST SUNDAYS: Sunday next is the Solemnity Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven. This makes it a very special day for us to celebrate. As stated in item one above, please note that there will be no vigil Mass next Saturday (5th Saturday). Perhaps the 5pm Mass at Leura might help?

The following Sunday (8/6), the Queen's Birthday weekend, is another Solemnity Feast, that of Pentecost Sunday, when we celebrate the spectacular arrival of the Holy Spirit into our lives. Pentecost Sunday is also the last day of the Easter Season – and the last day the Paschal candle is lit during Mass this year!

BAPTISMS: There have been a number of baptisms carried out here over the last couple of months. However, I have not mentioned them because of a shortage of bulletin space. However, following today's Mass at 11.30am, little Isabella Romao-Silva, daughter of Christine and Antonio, is to be baptised at the ripe old age of two months. Congratulations to Isabella, her parents and their wider family! Welcome to God's family, and to our Sacred Heart Parish!

DWF TIME: Seems that every time we turn around there is another special collection seeking our financial support.
