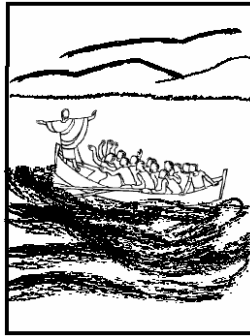

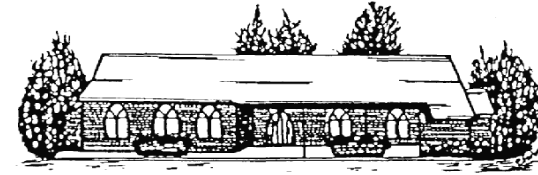

'How is it you have no faith?'

There are many ways of understanding faith. For each one of us, one or other aspect of Christian life makes more of an impact on us. What Paul sees in Christ is the great messenger of reconciliation. His first conviction is that, with the death of Christ, a new age has begun for divided humanity. If he died for all, all have died, namely the whole history and wisdom of people before him have been surpassed and now God works among us in other ways.

'We do not judge anyone by the standards of the flesh, even if we did once know Christ in the flesh ...' Christian faith is not only a new way of looking at God, it also includes a plan for a new society and a new life together. It is the will to dedicate ourselves with all possible means to reconcile people.
