

CONFIRMATION

I am currently preparing one of our adult parishioners to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Somehow, in his receipt of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation) the Sacrament of Confirmation was left out.

There is a feeling among some Catholics that Confirmation is almost an optional Sacrament. It isn't! Confirmation imparts a true strengthening of our spiritual character through the increased presence of the Holy Spirit in us. It is very similar to a young person maturing into adulthood in their lives.

While we receive the gift of the presence of the Holy Spirit within the Sacrament of Baptism, the Holy Spirit's presence can be likened to the first instalment of this Sacrament, the second and final part of which is the particular Sacrament of Confirmation. We need to understand that our Eternal Father and his only Son, Jesus, work in us through the Holy Spirit as occurred in the coming Feast of Pentecost, when the timidity of the Apostles confined fearfully in that one room, found the courage through the Holy Spirit to speak out – to preach – to the multi-lingual crowd gathered to hear them proclaim Jesus' good news. Through Confirmation we too are strengthened so as to impart that same good news to our generation.

Perhaps we need to be reminded of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, which is ours through this Sacrament. These gifts are: <u>Wisdom</u> (to be truly wise to follow God's way), <u>Understanding</u> (helps us to see things as God sees them); <u>Right Judgement</u> (helps us to recognise the difference between good and bad according to God's Law); <u>Courage</u> (strengthens us to follow God's way whatever hardships ensue); <u>Knowledge</u> (enables us to recognise God's goodness, greatness and kindness to us); <u>Reverence</u> (helps us to love, honour and respect God) and <u>Awe</u> (assists us to appreciate the wonder of God).

Given this great gift, we are reinforced in our acceptance of the need for, and obligations appended to, this strengthening Sacrament of Confirmation.
